Summary of Incident

Summary of How the Death Occurred: (max. 30,000 characters)

Summary:

On June 6, 2022, at 9:30am., Officers were notified that Mr. White had committed a murder in the Houston area earlier during the day. Officers spot Mr. White around 10:30 am and followed the decedent while waiting for additional uniformed officers. Uniformed officers then attempted a traffic stop and Mr. White fled from officers in the vehicle he was driving. Mr. White then drove to the residence of a girlfriend and barricaded himself inside of his vehicle. The vehicle was parked in the driveway of the girlfriends residence. The Dallas Police SWAT unit responded to the location and began negotiations with Mr. White. During negotiations Mr. White held a handgun to his chest throughout the incident. After some time, Mr. White refused to comply with the SWAT teams commands. Gas rounds was authorized by SWAT commanders and a single gas round was deployed at the vehicle. The round did not successfully enter the passenger compartment. The gas round struck a rear head rest and fell into the bed of the truck. Mr. White then fired a single gunshot into his chest. Mr. White then exited his vehicle and fell to the ground. SWAT operators and a SWAT doctor immediately provided medical care to the decedent. Mr. White was transported to the hospital where the emergency room doctor pronounced Mr. White deceased at 2:33pm. No police personnel or any other law enforcement discharged their weapons during this incident. Mr. Whites handgun was recovered in the passenger seat of his vehicle. An Autopsy was performed on Mr. White and the results are pending. The ME informed that a single gunshot wound was noted during the autopsy to Mr. Whites chest area.
