## Summary of Incident

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### Summary of How the Death Occurred: (max. 30,000 characters)

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#### Summary:

On August 17, 2022 at 12:18 p.m., Dallas Police went to 221 Starr Street, a residence belonging to the deceased. Officers were at the location investigating a tip regarding stolen vehicles being stripped. Officers knocked on the front door which was opened by Mr. Ramos. Mr. Ramos observed officers and immediately closed the door. Officers then ran to the back of the house where several individuals were observed stripping a stolen car. Those individuals then ran into Mr. Ramos' house in an attempt to hide. Police surrounded the house, after officers located multiple stolen cars on the property.

Swat was called to the location and those individuals exited the house and surrendered to police. The individuals stated Mr. Ramos was hiding in the attic and refused to comply with officers' commands to come out of the house. SWAT officers placed a OC and CS gas into the residence in an attempt to get Mr. Ramos out of the house peacefully.

Mr. Ramos refused to comply with the officers' commands. At about 6:50 p.m., SWAT officers entered the residence and located Mr. Ramos hiding in an air duct inside the attic. Mr. Ramos appeared to be suffering a heat-related medical emergency and was transported to a local hospital. Mr. Ramos arrived at the hospital at 7:04 p.m., where medical staff worked on him until 7:53 p.m., when Dr. Stewart Master pronounced him deceased.

The deceased was in the attic for several hours, with the outside temperature over 100 degrees. An autopsy was performed by the Dallas County Medical Examiner with the results pending.
