Summary:

On January 3, 2023 at about 10:00PM, Dallas Police patrol officers responded to a request to assist Dallas Fire Rescue (DFR) with a combative patient at 5122 Cardiff St. The subject's family called 9-1-1 due to their belief the subject was exhibiting bizarre behavior. DFR personnel encountered the subject at 5122 Cardiff. The subject's brother was also present at and was attempting to control the subject. DFR personnel requested assistance from Dallas Police who responded and attempted to handcuff the subject. Responding officers were able to place the subject in handcuffs with minimal force and he was subsequently placed on a stretcher and loaded into the DFR unit for transport. While enroute to Charlton Methodist Hospital, the subject went into cardiac arrest and was later pronounced deceased by the attending physician at 11:19PM. A Dallas Police officer who was riding in the DFR Unit captured video of the incident on his BWC.

Dallas County Medical Examiner performed an autopsy and the results are pending. The incident is being investigated by the Dallas Police Department's Special Investigations Unit and the Dallas County District Attorney's Office.
