Summary:

On August 27, 2023, at approximately 1806 hours, Inmate Mora was in the initial Intake process; however, there was no commitment issued at the time of the medical emergency. During the booking intake process, Inmate Mora, Emmanuel #821633 became agitated and aggressive toward the BCSO Booking Staff. A Code 2 (request for officer assistance) was initiated, and Inmate Mora was placed in hand and leg restraints (double-locked). After the restraints were applied, RN Starnes attempted to obtain vital signs for Inmate Mora; however, he was unresponsive. Two doses of NARCAN were administered to Inmate Mora but appeared to have no affect. At approximately 2015 hours, Inmate Mora ceased resistance and his body went limp. A Code 1 Blue (immediate Medical Emergency) was activated and life saving measures were initiated by RN Starnes and SERT Deputy J. Hernandez #1626. A third dose of NARCAN was administered by RN Galindo at approximately 2027 hours. Life saving measures continued until approximately 2040 hours; when SAFD/EMS arrived and took over life saving measures and continued until approximately 2101 hours when Captain Keller, SAFD, pronounced Inmate Mora deceased.
