Summary of Incident

Summary of How the Death Occurred: (max. 30,000 characters)

Summary:

1. On February 24, 2024 - Detectives with the Comal County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division as well as the Texas Rangers responded to an in-custody death report at the Comal County Jail located at 3000 IH 35 S. New Braunfels, TX 78130. The inmate/decedent was identified as Bart Joseph Bond.
2. The decedent was an inmate at the Comal County Jail. At approximately 2200 hours, the decedent was found by staff sitting on his bed hyperventilating. Jail personnel and jail medical personnel responded to the cell. The decedent became unresponsive and 9-1-1 was dialed. Firefighter/paramedics responded to the scene. The decedent was moved to the floor and lifesaving methods were administered. Firefighters/paramedics of the New Braunfels Fire Department Station #2 arrived to the scene. Firefighter/paramedics assumed lifesaving measures and despite all effort's death was pronounced at 2235 hours. The decedent was last seen at approximately 2200 hours. He recently complained of difficulty breathing, chest pain, pain in his right arm, and a head rash. The decedent had several physical ailments to include asthma as well as psychological conditions. The decedent had an X-Ray, COVID test and EKG done on February 23, 2024, and all results apparently came back clear. The decedent was observed at 2045 hours at med pass and medical staff advised that the decedent took his medications with no incident.
3. There is a known medical history of multiple blood sugar checks by staff. There is a known history of unspecified suicidal ideations. There is no known history of any prior suicide attempts. There is no known history of alcohol, drug, or tobacco abuse.
4. The scene was a day room in a pod and a jail cell, at the Comal County Jail. The pod number was identified as M 125 and the decedent's cell was MMH C. The decedent's cell door appeared operational with obvious signs of defects. Four cells were noted in the pod. The decedent was noted lying in the doorway of his cell and the dayroom. Multiple medical devices, commissary items, books, and other miscellaneous items were noted in the cell.
5. The decedent is a 33-year-old Caucasian man with a shaved head, brown eyes, all natural teeth, and

unshaven face. The decedent was observed lying supine on the floor in the doorway of his cell. The decedent's head appeared to the south and his feet appeared to the north. The decedent was noted wearing a white shirt, white underwear, and gray/brown pants. A medical tube was noted in place to the mouth. An endotracheal tube holder was noted fixed to the face. Defibrillation patches were noted to the chest and left lateral torso. An impression consistent with the use of an automated cardiopulmonary resuscitation device was noted to the chest. An intraosseous catheter was noted to the right leg. Two apparent abrasions were noted to the head. A bluish-purple hue was noted to the fingernails on the right hand. A bluish-purple hue was noted to the fingernails on the left hand. The back was unremarkable. A tattoo of a skull and apparent tribal lines were noted to the chest. A tattoo of apparent tribal lines was noted to the right shoulder and bilateral arms. A tattoo of barbed wire was noted to the right lower arm. A tattoo of a cross was noted to the left lower leg. Tache noir was noted to the bilateral eyes. Rigor was noted to be absent from the body. Lividity blanched with light pressure and appeared consistent with the decedent's position upon my arrival.

5. No items of evidentiary value were located or collected. Overall view photographs of the dayroom and the decedent's cell as well as midrange view and close view photographs of the decedent were taken. All photographs were taken using a Canon EOS digital camera with an 18-55mm lens. A total of 161 photographs (IMG_7401-IMG_7561) were taken and uploaded into the Comal County Sheriff's Command Upload program.

6. The decedent identified as Bart Joseph Bond was identified by comparison to his inmate identification card. Brenda Bond was identified by Deputies of the Comal County Sheriff's Office as the decedent's next of kin and was notified of the death. Foul play is not suspected. No signs of trauma were noted. The decedent was transported from the scene to the Doeppenschmidt Funeral home by their attendants. A death inquest was sent to Justice of the Peace #2, the Honorable James Walker. Judge Walker ordered a full autopsy to be completed by the Travis County Medical Examiner's Office.

7. Autopsy completed on 05/23/24, by Travis County Deputy Medical Examiner Jennifer Dierksen, MD. The report listed manner of death as natural and cause of death to be Pulmonary artery thromboembolus due to deep venous thrombosis.
