SYNOPSIS OF MURDER/ SUICIDE, AGGRAVATED ASSAULT ON A PUBLIC SERVANT BASED ON BODY WORN CAMERA VIDEO, OFFICER AND WITNESS ACCOUNTS:

On February 18, 2021 at approximately 10:55 a.m. Dallas 911 received a call from a male who identified himself as Sergio Sanchez, a 57 year old Latin male and stated that he had just shot and killed his wife, who was later identified as April Sanchez, a 31 year old white female. Suspect Sanchez also stated that he was upset because police officers had been drugging his wife. Suspect Sanchez also told the dispatcher that he could not stay on the phone and that he was going to go be with his wife.

The 911 dispatcher alerted responding officers to the nature of the call and Suspect Sanchez' state of mind. Responding officers met just east of the call location to formulate a plan and brief each other on the approach. The officers then made a tactical approach to the residence. Upon approach, Suspect Sanchez fired several times at the officers through a window, striking Officer Rubin and Officer Coffie in their lower legs. The officers determined that the shots were coming from the front window of the location and retreated to hard cover. Officers Rubin and Coffie were transported to by DFR 8 to Baylor Hospital while Suspect Sanchez remained inside the location and refused to communicate any further. Sergeant Mullen, who was already on scene, set up a perimeter and contacted SWAT.

The SWAT team responded to the scene and began preparing to conduct surveillance using a remote-controlled camera system. The SWAT was able to introduce the system through a broken window and determined that both Suspect S. Sanchez and Complainant A. Sanchez were deceased. They then breached the front door and made entry. The SWAT team conducted a primary and secondary search of the residence and called the location clear. They found Complainant A. Sanchez deceased and Suspect S. Sanchez near her, deceased from what appeared to be a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

SWAT physician, Doctor Alex Eastman was on scene and pronounced the suspect and the complainant dead at approximately 1:00 p.m.

CSRU responded to Baylor Hospital, photographed the injured officers and collected evidence. CSRU then responded to 5327 Bonita Avenue, processed and collected evidence, and performed a LEICA Scan of the crime scene. The BWC Team responded and downloaded all relevant video. SIU responded to the scene and determined that the SWAT team would not be treated as involved officers because the suspect had shot himself before they arrived on the scene. The Dallas County District Attorney responded and is conducting an independent investigation. Next of Kin notifications have been made for both the suspect and the complainant.

Suspect S. Sanchez has a history of arrests for violent offenses including Aggravated Sexual Assault, Aggravated Robbery and Kidnapping. The suspect is also a registered Sex Offender.

Dallas Police Department's Special Investigations Unit will be conducting the continuing investigation on case number 028292-2021. Detective Brian Fillingim will be the lead detective.
